Information

Denver Water periodically disposes of fleet vehicles and equipment that are below minimum operating and fleet maintenance standards. During 2009, surplus vehicles/equipment and miscellaneous items were auctioned to the high bidder at auctions conducted by Roller & Associates, Inc.

The results of the auctions for 2009 are summarized on the attached tabulation for the information of the Board.

The total amount received from Roller & Associates, Inc. for sixty (60) fleet units was \$139,600.00. The total amount received from Roller & Associates, Inc. for miscellaneous surplus was \$3,271.19.

For comparison, the total for 2008 was nineteen (19) fleet units at \$41,140.00 and miscellaneous surplus of \$2,590.00.


In addition, the amount received from Iron and Metals, Inc. for scrap metal sales totaled \$35,276.87.

Equipment used for trade-ins yielded \$355,383 (2 Ford tractors, 2 John Deere graders) 2 Caterpillar Excavators, 1 Caterpillar loader, 1 Caterpillar tractor/dozer/crawler, 2 International utility trucks, and 3 New Holland tractor/backhoe/loaders).


