



20th Avenue and Quail Staging Area

Dear resident,

The Ashland Reservoir Tank Replacement Project is under way in the city of Wheat Ridge located at West 29th and Fenton Avenue. Western Summit Constructors (WSCI) has been hired by Denver Water to demolish two existing 20 million gallon water basins and replace them with two 10 million gallon cast in place concrete tanks. The project requires a mass excavation removing soil for the construction of the new cast in place concrete water tanks. The soil that is to be excavated will be removed from the site using designated haul routes, and stored in the North portion of Denver Waters property located on 20th Avenue and Quail Street. The soil stored at the site is required to be graded in accordance with a permit issued by the City of Lakewood, and better management practices will be in place to control the dust from leaving the property.

As you may have noticed, construction fencing has been installed at the 20th and Quail location to separate the North half of the lot from the South half. The North half will be closed to public for the duration of the project while the South half remains open for public use.

Over the next four years, soil will continue to be removed from the site at 29th and Fenton as needed and brought to Denver Waters property. As soil is needed back on site, it will be removed from the 20th and Quail location. The project is scheduled to be completed in early 2017.
