Tabulation of Bids for Aggregate Base Course

Information

The aggregate base course is needed to satisfy City and State regulations requiring a minimum depth of 18" of aggregate base course immediately beneath the pavement in all street cuts requiring backfill and paving.

The material will be primarily delivered by the supplier, but Denver Water trucks will sometimes perform this task. The bid documents indicated the contract would be awarded as a single contract.

Request for bids were sent to forty-four potential bidders, and faxed to eight SBE organizations. Denver Water received a total of seventeen responses, as per the attached tabulation. There was one SBE respondent. The low bid was submitted by LaFarge West, Inc. Prices are firm for the entire contract period.


The previous contract for aggregate base course was awarded December 18, 2008 to Albert Frei & Sons, Inc.

Funds will be included in the 2010 through the 2012 Budgets for this expenditure (MPC 5AZ0002).

Recommendation:

It is recommended the Board authorize the award of Contract Number 12669A to LaFarge West, Inc., to furnish aggregate base course, for the contract period February 1, 2010 through January 31, 2012, for a total contract amount of \$300,000.00.
