



29<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Gray Street Intersection Closure Notification

Dear Resident,

The Ashland Reservoir Tank Replacement Project is coming along smoothly. All of the under slab piping for the first tank has been installed and it is time to begin forming for the cast in place concrete slab. Prior to the concrete slab being poured, the new drain line down Gray Street must be finished which will require the intersection of 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Gray Street to be closed. Western Summit Constructors, Inc. subcontractor T-Lowell has received a Right Of Way Permit from the City of Wheat Ridge to close the intersection of 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Gray Street starting the Wednesday after the Thanksgiving Holiday, 12/04/13 for three weeks until 12/23/2013. All East and West bound traffic on 29<sup>th</sup> avenue will be detoured to use either 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue or 26<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

The City of Wheat Ridge has also granted WSCI permission to work Saturdays and Sundays between 12/04 – 12/23 in order to shorten the length of time required to complete the work.

WSCI would like to thank the local community affected by the 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Gray Street intersection closure and appreciates your cooperation and understanding.
