## Authorization of Additional Funds for Gate Valves and Tapping Valves

Information

Resilient seated gate valves and tapping valves are stock items used for new installations and replacements in Denver Water's distribution system. The Board entered into Contract No. 13205A with Mueller Company, Ltd. ("Mueller") on November 1, 2010 to furnish resilient seated gate valves and tapping valves. The original contract period is November 1, 2010 through October 31, 2011, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$400,000.00.

Denver Water and Mueller have mutually agreed upon a contract extension date of October 31, 2012, through which Mueller has agreed to furnish the seated gate valves and tapping valves to Denver Water at the same prices as contained in the original contract.

Gate valve and tapping valve costs are allocated to specific projects throughout the budget as Materials & Supplies Issued from Inventory (Stores Issues). These costs are included in the 2011 and 2012 budgets.

### Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board authorize the additional funds for Contract No. 13205A to Mueller in the amount of \$350,000.00, for a total compensation not to exceed \$750,000.00, and extend the contract completion date to October 31, 2012.


