Information

On February 25, 2010, bids were received for the 2010 Pipe Rehabilitation Project. The project consists of cleaning and cement mortar lining 34,200 feet of 6-inch to 12-inch diameter cast iron water mains.

Three bids were received. The selection of a contractor was based on a Quality Based Selection process where 60% of the score was based on price, 30% on qualifications, and 10% on a Contractor's Statement of Added Value. Denver Water may retain the selected contractor for work on the next two year's projects in order to have continuity and improve efficiency of the program. The selection process identified Mainlining Service, Inc. of Elma, New York, who was the low bidder with the amount of \$2,690,814.00. The Engineer's Estimate for the work was \$3,500,000.00.

The Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) goal for this project has been established as 5% participation of the total project amount. Mainlining Service, Inc. achieved 6.09% MWBE participation.

The 2010 Capital Improvement Plan (MPC 2DD0145) includes funds for this project.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended the Board award Contract 12729A to Mainlining Service, Inc. for the 2010 Pipe Rehabilitation Project in the amount of \$2,690,814.00.


