**Contract extension for Enterprise System Integration Services

Information

In April, 2014, Denver Water entered into an agreement with Materials Software Systems, Inc., for enterprise system integration services to be provided by Prasad Koukuntla. Enterprise system integration services involve the implementation of technologies that allow enterprise application systems to interface with each other. For instance, the mobile system (mPlatform) interfaces with the work and asset management system (Maximo), which interfaces with the GIS system and the finance system (JDE). These system integrations are implemented using TIBCO middleware and other software integration tools.

Continuation of these services is necessary through 2015 to keep up with new system integration requirements associated with the ORCA project and others, as well as assist in the cross-training of a new employee on the IT Integration Services team. Services provided under this contract will be charged at the existing rate of \$85.00/hour. Funding for this contract extension is fully budgeted in the IT Enterprise Integration Services 2015 budget (Cost Center 172, MPC: 4JN0100).

Recommendation:




