This agenda item requests Board approval for changes to the Personnel Policies required .

Chapter 13 Licenses and Certifications

Due to recent changes to Colorado's Revised Statutes, it is necessary for Denver Water to modify its Personnel Policies regarding temporary driver's licenses and revoked licenses.


C.R.S. 42-2-126 (3)(a)(I) was modified so that a person driving with blood alcohol content exceeding 0.08 shall have his license revoked for 3 months. Therefore, Personnel Policy sec. 13-1-(4) should be changed to state "3 months" rather than "90 days."

C.R.S. 42-2-126 (6)(d) states that a driver's license may be revoked seven days after the driver receives notice of revocation. C.R.S. 42-2-(7)(d) states that a driver may request a hearing during that seven day period and may then receive a temporary permit. The statutes do not specify that a temporary permit is valid for only seven days. Therefore, Personnel Policy sec. 13-1-(2)(c) should be changed to delete the reference to a seven day temporary permit.


RECOMMENDATION:
