**TASK ORDER AGREEMENT WITH  
BLACK & VEATCH CORPORATION FOR THE  
MARSTON FILTER PLANT 2 CONSTRUCTION**

On July 9, 2008, the Board entered into an Agreement with Black and Veatch Corporation to provide engineering services for the final design of filtration system improvements to Plant 2 at Marston Water Treatment Plant. The Contract was executed for an amount not to exceed \$950,304.00.

At this time, the final design is complete and a task order for consultant construction phase services has been negotiated in the amount of \$277,171.00. *(Note: Although the Task Order Agreement contract was used for Denver Water's convenience, the Consultant was procured under a separate solicitation, and an On-Call Contract was not used.)*

A major portion of the construction phase services will be performed with in-house resources. The Consultant's fee is within normally accepted limits when considered as a percentage of the estimated construction cost.

*The MWBE goal for this project is being obtained through the construction contractors, and the original designers will complete these services during construction.*

The 2009 and 2010 Capital Improvement Plan (MPC 1CE0956) included funds for this work.

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended the Board award Task Order Agreement 11417C to Black & Veatch Corporation for the Marston Filter Plant 2 Construction for an amount of \$277,171.00 and the completion date of December 31, 2010.


