Information

A major component of Denver Water's Conservation Plan is assisting the State to set an example for water conservation efforts and the elimination of water waste. The plan anticipates spending up to \$500,000 per year for this purpose. The Board and the State entered into an overall Water Saving Agreement dated November 14, 2008, which provided for the purchase by the Board of water-saving technologies to be installed at State facilities.

This Letter Agreement provides for the purchase of numerous bathroom fixtures for the Auraria campus at a cost of \$225,500. The devices will be installed by the State and are expected to result in water savings of 2.22 gallons per toilet flush, 2 gallons per urinal flush, and 1 gallon per hand wash. The total water savings from these retrofits is estimated at over 27 acre feet, with a cost of \$7339.00 per acre foot of water saved.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board approve the Water Saving Agreement for the Auraria Campus at a cost of \$225,500.
