Information

Cherry Creek School District (CCSD) operates many buildings with inefficient plumbing fixtures and owns numerous properties with opportunities for landscape conservation. This Suburban Water Saving Agreement represents the first phase of a multiyear project with CCSD and provides for the retrofit of toilets and urinals at a total cost of \$261,000. The estimated water savings resulting from the retrofit is 59.11 acre feet, which averages \$4,400 per acre foot saved.

This conservation project is similar to efforts underway with Denver Public Schools and Jefferson County Public Schools. This agreement has an option for the fixtures to be purchased by Denver Water or to be purchased by CCSD, with reimbursement being handled similar to the rebate program.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board approve this Suburban Water Saving Agreement with Cherry Creek School District for \$261,000.
