**Second Amendment to Agreement with Deere and Ault Consultants, Inc.  
For the Hazeltine Reservoir Slurry Wall Investigation

Information

On May 2, 2013, the Manager approved an agreement with Deere & Ault Consultants, Inc. for the Hazeltine Reservoir Slurry Wall Investigation. The original contract was for an amount not to exceed \$52,888.00. The first amendment to this Agreement was for a time extension.

This Second Amendment to Agreement 14997A is for Deere & Ault Consultants, Inc. to provide engineering services for the Hazeltine Reservoir West Slurry Wall Replacement Project. This project is necessary since Urban Drainage and Flood Control District constructed a spillway from Howe-Haller B to the South Platte River through the Hazeltine Slurry Wall. This project is not related to the September 2013 flooding. The project involves the design of new a parallel soil-bentonite slurry wall to replace the compromised section of the existing slurry wall near the Bull Seep in the amount of \$64,680.00.

The 2013-2014 Capital Improvement Plan (MPC 1AL0206) includes sufficient funds for this project.

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board authorize the Second Amendment to Agreement 14997A to Deere & Ault Consultants, Inc. for the Hazeltine Reservoir Slurry Wall Investigation Project in the amount of \$64,680.00.
