Information

On April 21, 1989, Denver Water entered in to an Intergovernmental Agreement for the joint management of recreation at Dillon Reservoir with Summit County, the Town of Frisco, the Town of Dillon and the U.S. Forest Service. That agreement is set to expire in 2014.

Intergovernmental Agreement 15133A replaces the 1989 Agreement and continues the cooperative shared management of recreational activities at Dillon Reservoir for 25 more years. Functions include managing special events and special use requests and developing and enforcing recreational rules and regulations.

Because of federal restrictions, the U.S. Forest Service cannot participate in intergovernmental agreements. To maintain the U.S. Forest Service as a party to the shared recreational management at Dillon Reservoir, a Memorandum of Understanding component was included in the agreement.


**Recommendation**


