Tabulation of Bids for Tank Inspections and Testing at Foothill Treatment

Information

The Foothills treatment plant houses three chemical storage tanks that are considered pressures vessels and regulations require that they be inspected and tested on regular intervals. The testing and inspection is specialty work and Denver Water was able to identify only two contractors capable of performing this type of work.

The Invitation for Bids was sent to two prequalified bidders, both of which submitted a bid. The low bid was submitted by Cox Industrial Services, Inc. The scope of work includes inspection and testing of the tanks, rebuilding tank valves, and preparing a summary report documenting the findings. The contract also includes provisions for completing repair work identified during the inspections on a time and materials basis at defined rates. Cox inspected and tested the same tanks in 2007 and their work was good and met all requirements.


Monies for the tank inspections and testing at Foothills Treatment Plant is included in the Operations and Maintenance budget for 2012 under MPC 4CB0017.
