## Authorization of Additional Funds for Armed Guard Services

Information

Since May 17, 2008 armed security guard services were put in place twenty-four hours a day at the Dillon Dam. Security guards are responsible for securing the Dam, Dam Road (including east and west access points), Control House and the Hydro Facility. Currently three security guards are assigned to Dillon Dam. Two stationary security guards (one each) is assigned to the east and west entrance locations and the third position is utilized as a supervisor/roving security guard to patrol the facilities and perform relief duties. In addition, Williams Fork Dam & Reservoir also requires security guard services to control access to the site during the on-going construction activities which are scheduled to be completed by mid-year 2012.

The First Amendment to this Contact extends the current contract period for one additional year providing ongoing twenty-four hour a day armed security guard services as stated in the contract's "Scope of Work", at the Dillon Dam, and security guard services at Williams Fork Dam for the remaining period of the construction activities.

Costs for the armed guard services are included in the 2012 and 2013 Budget.

### Recommendation:


It is recommended that the Board authorize the additional funds for Contract No. 12944A to Specialized Protective Services LLC in the amount of \$60,000.00, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$2,560,000.00; and extend the contract completion date to April 30, 2013.


