Information

On June 17, 2014, proposals were received for the Marston Treatment Plant Flocculation and Sedimentation Equipment Replacement Project. The project includes all labor, materials, and equipment including the following major components: Demolition of existing flocculation and sedimentation equipment, installation of OWNER-pre-selected flocculation and sedimentation equipment, demolition of three motor control centers (MCCs) and local control panels (LCPs), and installation of new MCCs, LCPs, and associated conduit, conductors, and appurtenances.

There were eight pre-qualified General Contractors. Four proposals were received and the lowest qualified proposal was submitted by Archer Western Construction, LLC of Westminster, Colorado in the amount of \$7,346,103.00. The Engineer's Estimate for the work was \$8,500,000.00.

*The Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) goal established for this construction project is 1% participation due to minimal participation opportunities. Archer Western Construction, LLC achieved 1.02% MWBE participation.*

The 2014-2015 Capital Improvement Plan (MPC 2CE0520) includes sufficient funds for this project.

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board approve Contract 15326A to Archer Western Construction, LLC for the Marston Treatment Plant Flocculation and Sedimentation Equipment Replacement in the amount of \$7,346,103.00.
