Tabulation of Bids for Trench Rotomilling

Information

Trench rotomilling is a process by which asphalt or concrete is reduced to a pulverized state, with the resulting pulverized material being of a consistency that allows it to be used as backfill. This results in savings through reduced hauling of waste material.

Requests for bids were sent electronically via Rocky Mountain E-Purchasing System to 213 companies and emailed to eight SBE organizations. The documents were opened by 15 companies and Denver Water received two responses, both of which are SBE's. The low bid was submitted by TMT Cutters Inc. and the proposed unit prices are on average 15% less than the previous contract.


Trench rotomilling is one of many contracts used on a variety of transmission and distribution projects and is budgeted in the line item for Construction Services. The 2011 budget includes sufficient funds anticipated for this contract. Since the contract and annual budget cycles are not aligned, funds will also be included in the 2012 and 2013 budget for this item.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board authorize award of Contract No. 13500A to TMT Cutters Inc. to furnish trench rotomilling for the period July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2013, for a total not to exceed \$210,000.00. This award is based on lowest price and compliance with the terms and conditions of the contract.
