Phil Ragsdale of The Confluence Group, Inc., has been engaged in the role of SOA Integration Architect, providing SOA based integration services for the Mobile workforce Automation and the Enterprise Asset Management system projects. Current plans for further development and deployment of MWFA and EAMS capabilities require an increased level of SOA integration work in order to maintain the planned delivery schedule. The integration components requiring additional work effort include:

- Asset migration and ARG (Asset Record Group) synchronization
- Flushing process -- round trip work order synchronization
- Flushing process -- Condition Monitoring data integration
- Locates process integrations
- Valve Exercise program integrations
- Hydrant Inspection program integrations
- Fireflow Testing integrations
- Work management system integration with ETMS (new time keeping system)
- Inventory / Materials integrations
- Purchase Requests integrations
- Purchase Orders integrations
- Invoice Reconciliation integrations
- Mobilized Warehouse Data Collection

This contract amendment will engage Max Pitard of The Confluence Group to provide the additional SOA integration work in the areas described above.

Services provided under this contract extension will be billed at the existing rate of \$120/hour


**RECOMMENDATION:**
