Information

Trench rotomilling is a process by which asphalt or concrete is reduced to a pulverized state, with the resulting pulverized material being of such consistency as to allow it to be used as backfill. This results in savings through reduced hauling of waste material. Denver Water uses rotomilling in advance of scheduled pipeline jobs to ensure a clean cut and proper repair of asphalt. We also use it on emergency jobs where asphalt has been damaged.


Requests for bids were sent to twenty-two companies, and faxed to nine SBE organizations, with two responding, as per the attached bid tabulation. The low unit pricing submitted by Alpha Milling Company is, on average, approximately 17% lower than the previous contract.

The previous provider of this service was TMT Cutters, Inc.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended the Board award Contract No. 12306A to Alpha Milling Company for the period July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2011, for a total contract amount of \$490,000.00. This award is based on lowest price and compliance with specifications. Funds are included 2009 Budget and will be included in the 2010 and 2011 Budgets for these expenditures (Various MPC's).
