Information

The 2009 Vault Rehabilitation project, which is scheduled for construction in 2010, includes the purchase of seven butterfly valves and actuators. The existing valve conditions are poor and deteriorating due to age and corrosion. Replacing these valves will increase Denver Water's personnel safety by providing tighter shutouts and better valve performance. Valve sizes range from 42-60 inches in diameter. The valves will be electrically and manually operated as requested by Treated Water Operations. Purchasing the valves now will allow sufficient time for delivery before vault improvement construction.

Requests for bids were sent to forty potential bidders, with five responding, as per the attached tabulation. There were no SBE's available to furnish these materials. The low bid was submitted by Val-Matic Valve & Manufacturing.


The previous supplier of butterfly valves and actuators was Val-Matic Valve & Manufacturing.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended the Board authorize the award of Contract No. 12343A to Val-Matic Valve & Manufacturing for butterfly valves and actuators for the 2009 Vault Rehabilitation project, for a total contract amount of \$186,340.13. This award is based on lowest price and compliance with specifications. Funds are included in the 2009 Budget for this expenditure (Various MPC's).
