Information

Due to the potential impact to Denver Water facilities, we are taking a proactive approach to our involvement with the potential infestation of Quagga and Zebra Mussel while being sensitive to ramifications on the economy of Colorado, particularly in Grand County.

To that end we have negotiated an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Colorado Division of Wildlife of the State of Colorado to provide recreational boat inspection and decontamination services for Williams Fork Reservoir.

These services have been taking place since July 1, 2008. The IGA will remain in effect for 5 years and the total compensation will be \$50,000.00 per calendar year, including 2008.

The 2009 Capital Improvement Plan (MPC 4AN0014) includes funds for this project

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board approve the IGA with the Colorado Division of Wildlife of the State of Colorado for an amount of \$50,000.00 per calendar year for a total of 5 years.
