Tabulation of Bids for Bituminous Cold Patching

Information

Bituminous cold-patching material is used as a temporary asphalt surface after streets have been cut to accommodate main installations or repairs to the water system. The use of cold patch is required by the City and County of Denver on major streets. Denver Water has tested and will continue to test other methods of temporary resurfacing in lieu of Bituminous cold-patching material.

Request for bids were sent to twenty-six potential bidders, including one SBE, and faxed to eight SBE organizations. Denver Water received a total of one response. The low bid price of \$63.21 per ton submitted by Aggregate Industries is relatively unchanged from the previous contract price.

The previous contract for bituminous cold-patching material was awarded to Colorado Asphalt Services, Inc. on November 8, 2006.


Funds will be included in the 2010, and 2011 Budgets for these expenditures (MPC 5AZ0002).

Recommendation:

It is recommended the Board authorize the award of Contract No. 12702A to Aggregate Industries, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,900,000.00, for the period January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2011. This award is based on acceptable price, delivery and compliance with specifications.
