**Tabulation of Bids for Disposal of Residuals**

Information

Denver Water will generate approximately 40,000 cubic yards (2,200 loads) of water treatment residuals (WTR) from Marston Water Treatment Plant and Ralston Reservoir during the next two years. Denver Water requires these WTR be disposed of, in either an approved landfill site or a Class I composting facility. This contract requires the Contractor to be responsible for both the hauling and disposal of the WTR.

Request for bids were sent to forty-three potential bidders, including four SBEs and faxed to eight SBE organizations. Denver Water received a total of six responses, as per the attached tabulation. Two of the responses were SBE's. The low bidder meeting specifications is A-1 Organics at \$429.00 per load.

The previous contract was awarded to A-1 Organics in December 13, 2006.

Funds will be included in the 2010 and 2011 Budgets for these expenditures (MPC 4CB0006).


Recommendation:


It is recommended the Board authorize the award of Schedule II of Contract No. 12471A to A-1 Organics for the hauling and disposal of residuals, for the period January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2011, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$943,800.00. This award is based on best price meeting specifications and A-1's Class I composting facility.
