Information

The Denver Federal Center (DFC) currently receives treated water from Denver Water via a single source 12" cast iron main installed circa 1964. New dedicated transmission facilities are necessary to provide a redundant source of treated water to the DFC.

PCL Construction Services, Inc. (PCL) is under contract with the DFC. PCL wishes to enter into a Participation Agreement with Denver Water so we can complete the work associated with providing the new transmission facilities to the DFC.

This work is not included in the 2010 Capital Plan.


Denver Water will be reimbursed for the work associated with providing the new transmission facilities. The total estimated reimbursement cost for this work is \$2,542,000.00, payable as shown below:

- 5% after Participation Agreement is executed
- 5% after design agreement is executed
- 40% after construction contract is awarded
- 40% after construction is 50% complete
- 10% after new facilities are in service

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board authorize Agreement 12701A with PCL Construction Services, Inc. for Denver Water to provide new transmission facilities in the amount of \$2,542,000.00.


