Denver Water purchases desktop computer software and other infrastructure software product licenses (Windows PC Operating Systems, Client Access Licenses, MS Office Suite of Productivity tools, Exchange Server, SharePoint Server, SQL Server, Visio, Visual Studio and Windows Server Operating Systems), as well as associated annual maintenance & support services for these products from Microsoft Corp.

Denver Water has made these purchases under a three-year State of Colorado Master Software Agreement with Microsoft Corporation through a local reseller, Insight Public Sector, Inc. The current three-year agreement is ending on March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2014 and needs to be extended for an additional three years. The new three-year agreement has a total cost of \$2,173,063, or approximately \$724,355 per year. Funds for this these contract expenses are budgeted in MPC 4JN0006.

**RECOMMENDATION**


It is recommended that the Board approve this contract amendment with Insight Public Sector, Inc. for an additional three years in the amount of \$2,173,063 for new purchases and maintenance of Microsoft software. With this amendment, the total contract amount will be increased to \$5,588,963.


