**Pump 11 Replacement at Kendrick Pump Station

Information

On December 17, 2013, bids were received for a replacement pump for the Kendrick Pump Station Modification Project. Due to the long lead time of the pump, the equipment must be owner-furnished in order to meet the construction schedule. The pump replacement is a part of the Pump Station Visionary Plan and is required due to age and maintenance records.

An Invitation for Bids was sent to two prequalified bidders, both of whom responded. Letts, Van Kirk & Associates submitted the lowest bid and the fewest exceptions to terms. They also offered a 2% discount for paying net 10 and not paying with credit card, which Denver Water will take advantage of.

There was no Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) goal established for this project. The 2014 Infrastructure Master Plan (MPCs 2DB0330 and 2DB0339) includes sufficient funds for this project.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board approve Contract No. 15271A for Pump 11 Replacement at Kendrick Pump Station to Letts, Van Kirk & Associates for the term February 1, 2014, to July 31, 2015, for a total amount not to exceed \$213,147.06.


