



West 30th Ave. & Fenton/Grey Street Closure.

The Ashland Reservoir Tank Replacement Projects pipeline Subcontractor requested and received from the City of Wheat Ridge a Right Of Way (ROW) permit for the closing and detouring of the intersection of 30th Ave. and Fenton will begin during the week of 7/14/14 and will be completed in approximately 3 weeks. The purpose of the street closure is to connect an Inlet pipe to supply water to the holding tanks for the Ashland Reservoir Tank Replacement Project. A traffic control plan has been approved by the City of Wheat Ridge and is as follows.

- W. 30th and Fenton will be closed to thru traffic during the day, Fenton will be reopened at night once work commences for the day.
- W. 30th will be closed between Fenton and Gray. Gray St. and Harlan will only be accessible from W. 32nd.
- No street parking will be permitted on W. 30th between Gray and Fenton.
