2010 Disposal of Used Vehicles and Equipment

Information

Denver Water periodically disposes of fleet vehicles and miscellaneous equipment that are below minimum operating and fleet maintenance standards. During 2010, surplus vehicles/equipment and miscellaneous items were auctioned to the high bidder at auctions conducted by Roller & Associates, Inc.

Denver Water sent forty (40) fleet units to auction in 2010 and received \$108,665.00. Denver Water also received \$8,736.36 for miscellaneous surplus items. An additional \$4,700.00 was received for "special use" surplus equipment (motors, two-way radios and copy equipment) that historically yields little interest and revenue when sent to traditional auction firms. The total received overall for 2010 was \$122,101.36.

In addition, the amount received in 2010 from Iron and Metals, Inc. for scrap metal sales totaled \$61,886.87.

Equipment used for trade-ins yielded \$68,500.00 (1997 International 10 yard dump truck; 1996 International 10 yard dump truck; 1995 L8000 Ford 10 yard dump truck; 1998 410e John Deere backhoe; 1999 675e New Holland backhoe; and Caterpillar D4b Dozer).


