**Third Amendment for Asphalt and Concrete Paving Services

Information

Denver Water requires asphalt paving, concrete repairs, sawcutting, rotomilling and infrared pavement patching for the restoration of streets cut by Denver Water Transmission and Distribution crews during water system installations and repairs in the Denver Metropolitan area.

The current contract with Colorado Asphalt Services, Inc., Contract No. 13899A, will expire on January 31, 2015. Denver Water would like to extend Contract No. 13899A for three additional months and increase the contract amount to cover the time extension. The additional time will allow Denver Water to develop a comprehensive bid to secure the best market value for asphalt and concrete paving services and avoid any disruptions to repair operations.

Funds for asphalt and concrete paving services are included in the proposed 2015 Budget.

Recommendation:


