Master Meter, Read & Bill and Total Service Water Service Agreement – Alameda Water and Sanitation District

Action

Information

Since 1961, the Board has provided water service to Alameda Water and Sanitation District under two contracts; one Master Meter and one Read & Bill. The District has a number of customers along the boundary with the City of Denver at West Jewell Avenue and South Sheridan Boulevard who receive water via private wells. As the wells fail, the customers are connecting to the Denver distribution system because no District facilities are located near their properties. Each of these customers has been licensed through an individual connector's agreement with Denver Water and charged Total Service rates for water service.

In an effort to reduce the number of connector agreements, the District requested that their existing contracts be consolidated. The proposed consolidated water service agreement includes all required provisions of the existing Master Meter and Read & Bill contracts and has been expanded to include Total Service. Existing customers who are served via connector's agreements will be served under the new Total Service provisions. As properties are included in the Total Service area, they will be removed from the existing Read & Bill service area. Existing connector's agreements will be cancelled as customers are included into the District's Total Service area.

Recommendation:


It is recommended that the Board approve the proposed Master Meter, Read & Bill and Total Service agreement with Alameda Water and Sanitation District.


