## Tabulation of Bids for Cold Patch Material Contract # 15310A

Action by Consent

Action

Information

Denver Water uses cold-patching material as a temporary asphalt surface after streets have been cut to accommodate water main installations or repairs. The use of cold patch on major streets and arterials is required by various municipalities in our service area. Use of slow cure cold patching asphalt (diluted with petroleum solvent) is prohibited from March 1 through September 30 by Air Quality Control Commission (AQCC) Regulation No. 7, 5 CCR 1001-9XI. Denver Water has revised its material specifications to include cold patch material compliant with this regulation.

An Invitation for Bid was issued via the Rocky Mountain E-Purchasing System ("Bidnet") and sent to 10 MWBE and SBE trade organizations, with three companies responding. Two schedules were included in this bid: Schedule I includes the current slow cure cold-patching asphalt (diluted with petroleum solvent) material to be used from October 1 through February 28 and cold patch material (non-petroleum solvent containing asphalt) compliant with regulations to be used from March 1 through September 30; Schedule II includes the use of cold patch material (non-petroleum solvent containing asphalt) for year-round use. Denver Water's recommendation is to award Schedule I, a 1.25% savings over Schedule II or \$19,400 annually, to Colorado Asphalt Services, Inc. based on best price.

Funding for cold-patching material is included in the 2014 and 2015 ten year plan.

### Recommendation:


It is recommended that the Board authorize award of Contract No. 15310A to Colorado Asphalt Services, Inc. for cold patch material for the contract period April 1, 2014 through March 31, 2016, for a total contract amount of \$3,101,200.00.
