**Tabulation of Bids For
Resilient Seated Gate and Tapping Valves**

Information

Gate and tapping valves are stock items used for new installations and replacements to the distribution system. Bid documents stated awards would be made on an individual schedule basis, or combination of schedules. Schedule I is for gate valves and Schedule II is for tapping valves.

Requests for bids were downloaded by thirty potential suppliers and faxed to eight Chamber of Commerce organizations, with six responding, per the attached tabulation.

Mueller Company Ltd. is the low bidder for gate valves at \$342,262.13, tapping valves is also lower at \$28,244.90. Unit prices, on average, are 2.5% lower than the previous contract.

Gate and tapping valves costs will be budgeted to specific projects throughout the budget as Materials & Supplies Issued from Inventory (Stores Issues). The 2010 Stores Issue budget is \$11.5 million with \$9.8 million spent year to date.

Recommendation:


It is recommended the Board authorize the award of Contract No.13205A, Schedules I and II to Mueller Company Ltd., to furnish gate valves and tapping valves, for a total contract amount of \$400,000.00 for the period of November 1, 2010 through October 31, 2011. This award is based on the best price, acceptable delivery and compliance with Denver Water specifications.
