**INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA)  
FOR THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER'S  
WEST QUINCY AVENUE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Information

The City of Denver is widening West Quincy Avenue near Denver Water's Marston Water Treatment Plant. Back in 2005, Denver Water committed to paying for the repaving of Quincy that would be required as a result of this project. The design of this widening project now includes lowering the street, which will require relocation of portions of three Denver Water pipes: 60-inch Conduit No. 30, 54-inch Conduit No. 109 and a 12-inch main.

Denver Water is obligated to pay for pipe relocation required by road improvements under most circumstances. However, Denver Water owns some of the property on which the relocations will occur and is not responsible for that portion of the relocation costs.

The City will bid and oversee construction of the relocation project. The IGA provides that Denver Water will contribute \$1.404 million to this project, \$1,149,000 for relocation costs attributable to the right-of-way, and \$255,000 for paving costs as agreed in the 2005 agreement. Denver Water will also convey right-of-way for Quincy Avenue to the City without cost.

The 2010 Capital Improvement Plan (MPC 2DD1001) includes sufficient funds for this project.

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended the Board execute Intergovernmental Agreement 13326A to allow for the reimbursement of \$1,404,000.00 to the City for Denver Water's portion of the West Quincy Avenue Relocation Project.




