



29th Avenue & Gray Street Closure Notification

The Ashland Reservoir Tank Replacement Projects pipeline Subcontractor requested and received from the City of Wheat Ridge a Right Of Way (ROW) permit for the closing and detouring of the intersection of West 29th Avenue and Gray Street next week between Tuesday June 18, and Friday June 21. The purpose of the street closure is to allow storm sewer relocations for the Ashland Reservoir Tank Replacement Project. A traffic control plan has been approved by the City of Wheat Ridge and is as follows.

- West 29th Avenue will be closed to through traffic between Gray Street and Fenton Street.
- Any East bound traffic on 29th Avenue West of Pierce Street will be detoured to 26th Avenue.
- Gray Street will be closed to through traffic between 29th Avenue and 28th Avenue.
- Any North bound traffic on Gray Street South of 26th Avenue will be detoured to Pierce Street.
