Information

As a result of a recent Lean Rapid Improvement Event (RIE), Denver Water has decided to offer a service to customers with non-compliant meter pits. Meter pits are located on customer property and, therefore, their maintenance is a customer responsibility. Customers often do not have the knowledge or the time to research a contractor to perform repairs. Customer Relations wishes to contract with an on-call contractor to provide these repairs and then bill the customer accordingly.

The Invitation for Bids was sent to four bidders who were recommended by the department and 28 SBEs from a list provided by the City and County. There were three respondents, two of whom were found to be responsive and responsible. The proposal deemed in the best interest of Denver Water was from AGL Construction Company, a corporation in Good Standing with the Secretary of State and licensed by the City and County as a Water Service/Sewer Contractor. AGL Construction is certified as a small business enterprise (SBE).


Funding for customer meter pit repairs will be through a revenue budget offset.


Recommendation:
