**Tabulation of Bids for Transportation of Residuals

Information

Denver Water requires transportation of residuals from our water treatment plants to approved landfills. This hauling service is currently contracted with Republic Services, owner of one landfill we utilize, who then subcontracts the work. In order to improve service and directly contract the transportation, Denver Water published an Invitation for Bids for transportation of water treatment residuals generated by the Marston and Moffat water treatment plants.

The Invitation for Bids was downloaded by 15 potential bidders, 11 of whom were SBEs, and was e-mailed to 10 SBE trade organizations. Denver Water received a total of 2 responses, both of which were from SBEs. The low bid was submitted by Iron Woman Construction, the firm currently subcontracting the work from Republic Services.

Funds for Transportation of Hauling are included in the 2014 budget and will be included in the 2015-2016 budget under MPC 4HF0006.


Staff planned to present this item for approval at a previous Board meeting prior to commencement of the contract period stated in the Invitation for Bids. However, it was necessary to postpone due to unavoidable delays. Therefore, with the Board's approval, the contract will begin retroactively on April 11, 2014.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board authorize award of Contract No. 15146A to Iron Woman Construction for Transportation of Residuals for the contract period April 11, 2014 through April 10, 2016 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$164,298.00.


