**Contract Extension with Kforce, Inc. for GIS Software Developer**

Ryan Bae of Kforce, Inc. has been engaged as a GIS Software Developer, augmenting staffing in the Tier III New Solutions section of the Information Technology division since March of 2008. Ryan has contributed significantly to a number of Enterprise Asset Management initiatives, including:

- implementation of the redesigned GIS database
- implementation of an ArcGIS software upgrade
- implementation of new GIS maintenance tools for the Engineering Asset Recording Group

Over the past year, Ryan has been the primary developer on the Water Network Integration project, which provides the automated integration and synchronization of water system assets (valves, mains, conduits, vaults, pump-stations) between the GIS (Geospatial Information System) and MAXIMO (the enterprise work management system).

On a part time basis over the next twelve months, Ryan will complete the development work on the Water Network Integration project and additional enhancements to the GIS maintenance tools used by the Engineering Asset Recording Group.

Services provided under this contract extension will be charged at the current rate of \$105.00/hour. Funding for this contract extension is budgeted in the IT capital project budget (MPC: 3HN0006).

Recommendation:

It is recommended the Board approve this contract extension with Kforce, Inc. for the services of Ryan Bae for an additional twelve months, for an additional amount not to exceed \$105,000. This extension will bring the total contract amount with Kforce, Inc. to a total of \$558,600.
