Information

The State of Colorado, Office of Emergency Management, has a standard statewide IGA with local emergency management programs throughout Colorado that provides the terms and conditions under which the State and local entities can assist one another during disaster emergencies.

Emergency managers in Colorado know and understand that limited resources exist in the state. This IGA was established to provide emergency managers the ability to provide additional support beyond their own capabilities. There are no costs associated with this agreement. Each entity is responsible for its own costs incurred. Examples of activation of this agreement include: working in state or other local Emergency Operation Centers (EOCs) to support field operations that are responding to an emergency. (i.e., Lower North Fork Fire – local/state EOC operations, Windsor Tornado response, etc.)

The IGA serves the public interest and promotes the overall emergency management mission of developing, implementing and maintaining comprehensive, all-hazards emergency management programs. These programs cover prevention and preparedness, mitigation, response, and recovery with intentions of producing disaster resistive communities and organizations.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board approve the IGA for Emergency Management with the State of Colorado.
