Tabulation of Bids for Disposal of Residuals

Information

Denver Water will generate approximately 13,000 cubic yards (720 loads) of water treatment residuals ("WTR") from Marston Water Treatment Plant and Ralston Reservoir during the next two years. Denver Water requires the WTR be disposed of in either an approved landfill site or a Class I composting facility.

Denver Water must test the residuals for contamination levels to determine which facility can receive them, so it is difficult to estimate how much of Ralston Reservoir's residuals will go to which facility. This Contract secures pricing for the different scenarios that Denver Water may require for the disposal and/or hauling of the WTR.

Invitation for Bids was sent to three potential bidders, one of which is an SBE. All potential bidders responded, as per the attached tabulation. The low bidder for all schedules was Republic Services.


Funds for these expenditures are included in the 2012 budget and will also be included for 2013. The contract amount was estimated according to the highest potential cost and if the contract exceeds the budgeted amount, a variance will be requested.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board authorize the award of Contract No. 13854A to Republic Services for the hauling and disposal of residuals, for the period of January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2014, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$285,000.00.
