Information

On May 15, 2014, bids were received for the Denver International Airport 2014 Vault Improvements Project. The project includes all labor, materials, and equipment for rebuilding nine vaults to provide new hatches and improve drainage.

There were six pre-qualified General Contractors. Three bids were received and the lowest qualified bid was submitted by Interstate Highway Construction, Inc. of Englewood, Colorado in the amount of \$1,052,000.00. The Engineer's Estimate for the work was \$620,000.00. This estimate was based on two previous similar projects at Denver International Airport. Bidders determined that anomalies on two of the vaults made the work more extensive than was accounted for in the estimate.

The Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) goal established for this construction project is 5% participation. Interstate Highway Construction, Inc. achieved 5.07% MWBE participation.

The 2014 Capital Improvement Plan (MPC 2DE0100) includes sufficient funds for this project.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board approve Contract 15335A to Interstate Highway Construction, Inc. for the Denver International Airport 2014 Vault Improvements in the amount of \$1,052,000.00.




