In March of 2012, the Board approved a contract extension with The Doyle Group for the Database Administration services of Jeff Parton, at the rate of \$105/hour, through the end of 2013. Mr. Parton recently resigned from the Doyle Group, thus terminating his engagement through The Doyle Group with Denver Water.

A request for replacement contract candidates was extended to seven (7) local firms. Of the seventeen (17) candidates submitted, vetting and interviews identified the top three (3) candidates who participated in second interviews and Ying Jiang of Alumni Consulting Group, (a certified WBE firm) was selected as the best candidate for our needs, based on his knowledge, skills and experience.

This Database Administrator position is a core position in the IT division. It is anticipated that this core position will be filled by a regular employee in 2013 when a budget approved TO slot can be made available. In the meantime, it is necessary to extend these services on a contract basis.

Services provided under this contract will be charged at the rate of \$92.00/hour. Funding for this contract is fully budgeted in the Information Technology Professional Services budget (MPC: 4JA0100).

Recommendation:

It is recommended the Board approve this contract with Alumni Consulting Group, for the Database Administration services of Ying Jiang, through the end of 2013, for an amount not to exceed \$191,360.


