Tabulation of Bids for Waste Removal for Outlying Areas Contract # 14220A

Information

Denver Water requires waste removal services at its outlying facilities.

The Invitation for Bids was divided into seven schedules by location and advertised over the Rocky Mountain e-Purchasing System ("Bidnet"), where it was downloaded by 17 potential bidders. Denver Water received only one response for schedules III-VII from the incumbent, Waste Management of Colorado, Inc., who is not an SBE. No bids were submitted for schedules I-II.

In an effort to increase competition, research was performed to identify capable firms in the outlying areas who were interested in providing waste removal services, but might be unfamiliar with electronic bidding. The bid date was extended and one additional bid was received for one of the schedules. Ultimately, Waste Management was still significantly lower in price.


Funding for Waste Removal for Outlying Areas is currently in the 2012 and 2013 budgets under MPC 4AN0001 for Raw Water Storage Reservoirs.

Recommendation:




