



FROZEN GROUND DEPOSIT AGREEMENT

Soil amendment inspection when the ground is frozen: If, in the opinion of Denver Water, weather and ground conditions prevent the soil amendment inspection required for a meter-set, the applicant for the meter-set may deposit with Denver Water 25 percent of the SDC (System Development Charge) for the property, at which time Denver Water will schedule the meter inspection even though the soil amendment inspection has not occurred. The soil amendment inspection will then take place when conditions permit, and no later than June 1 each year.

Once the property has passed the soil amendment inspection, the soil amendment deposit will be refunded to the originator of deposit, regardless of ownership of the property. **NO INTEREST WILL BE PAID ON THE DEPOSIT.**

During the winter months check the Soil Amendment pages at denverwater.org to determine if soil amendment inspections are taking place.

If a passing soil amendment inspection has not been completed prior to June 1, 20____, I understand that the deposit will be forfeited and the inspection will no longer be required.

If a passing soil amendment inspection is achieved prior to the June 1 date, the deposit will be refunded to the person/company that originally submitted payment. Interest will not be added to the refund amount and Denver Water will not charge for the cost of issuing the refund.
