
The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) is rebuilding the US Highway 285 bridge over South Wadsworth Boulevard. The new bridge columns will straddle Denver Water's 60" Conduit No. 30. Although the bridge is not in direct conflict with the conduit, the new bridge configuration will obstruct Denver Water's maintenance access and would place a water line between bridge supports. CDOT was willing to accept the new configuration but Denver Water argued that the waterline required relocation.

A compromise was reached outlining a cost share of the Denver Water proposed waterline relocation. CDOT is willing to contribute a maximum of \$250,000.00 toward the estimated relocation cost of \$748,094.00.

The waterline relocation contract will be presented in a subsequent Board Item.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended the Board execute Contract 13264A with the Colorado Department of Transportation to allow for the reimbursement of \$250,000 toward the relocation of Conduit No. 30 in South Wadsworth Boulevard under US Highway 285.
