**Contract with The Doyle Group for

In October of 2011, the Board approved a contract extension with Prodigy Resources, LLC for the Infrastructure Technician services of Josh Ulmer, through the end of 2013, for the purpose of filling a core position in the IT division. It is anticipated that this core position will be filled by a regular employee sometime in 2013 when a budget approved TO slot can be made available.

Given certain performance concerns with the current contractor, IT plans to terminate the contract with Prodigy Resources and fill the role with another qualified contractor until a regular employee can be hired.

A recent request for Infrastructure Technician candidates was extended to approximately 50 IT staffing agencies. Resumes were submitted from 17 different agencies and screening interviews resulted in the top three candidates being brought in for face-to-face interviews. Based on his knowledge, skills and experience, this process has identified Chris Pesko of The Doyle Group to be an appropriate contractor for our current needs.

Services provided under this contract with the Doyle Group will be charged at the rate of \$90.00/hour. Funding for this contract is fully budgeted in the 2013 Information Technology Professional Services budget (MPC: 4JA0100).

Recommendation:

It is recommended the Board approve this contract with The Doyle Group, for the Infrastructure Technician services of Chris Pesko, through the end of 2013, for an amount not to exceed \$180,000.


