



Ashland Reservoir Tank 1 Base Slab Concrete Pour

Dear Resident,

The Ashland Reservoir Tank Replacement Project is preparing for the concrete placement of Tank 1. This pour will require roughly 1,250 cubic yards of concrete. This large amount of concrete requires WSCI to reserve the concrete supplier's batch plant for the whole day. Due to the batch plant's availability, the pour must take place during a weekend. The City of Wheat Ridge has granted permission for WSCI and the concrete subcontractor to pour the base slab this Saturday, Nov. 7.

Due to the small amount of available space around the project site, driving restrictions will be set in place for the day. There will be no parking on the west side of Fenton Street between 29th Avenue and 30th Avenue, and 30th Avenue between Fenton Street and Harlan Street will be limited to one-way traffic westbound and no public parking will be available. Harlan Street between 30th Avenue and 32nd Avenue will be limited to one-way traffic northbound.

A viewing station will be set up for the public on the west side of Fenton Street between 29th Avenue and 30th Avenue for local residents and guests to observe the concrete placement. The pour is scheduled to begin at 6:30 a.m. Saturday and will go late into the evening. The noise will be limited after the concrete is placed which will end around 5 p.m.
