**Contract Extension with Malcolm Pirnie, Inc.
for Software Development Services**

Contract# 12681A

Jerry Goetsch of Malcolm Pirnie, Inc. has been engaged as a Software Developer, augmenting staffing in the Tier III New Solutions Section of the Information Technology Division since November of 2009. Jerry has been leading the software development work on the new GIS map server application (the E-Map project) and developing integration solutions in support of asset synchronization with the GIS. Over the course of the next year, Jerry will complete the programming work for the initial release of the E-Map system as well additional incremental enhancement releases.

Services provided under this contract extension will be charged at the current rate of \$105.00/hour. Funding for this contract extension is budgeted in the Enterprise Asset Management System capital budget (MPC 3HN0006).

Recommendation:


