Intergovernmental Agreement for remote operation of certain water supply pumps

Information

Southgate Water and Sanitation District (District) is a Read and Bill distributor (Read and Bill #160) serving approximately 10,900 accounts. The District is generally located south of E. Quincy Ave., east of S. University Blvd. and west of S. I-25. Southgate was a Master Meter distributor from 1961 to 1967 when they entered into a Read & Bill contract With Denver Water (Board).

The District currently operates water supply pumps for water storage tanks which are downstream from Board operated facilities. The Board and District independently operate their facilities and frequently impact each other's operations.

The proposed intergovernmental agreement allows the Board to remotely operate certain District pumps to better manage storage tank levels and minimize operational impacts to the Board and District.


There is no anticipated budget impact as a result of the proposed intergovernmental agreement The District's Board has approved the proposed Intergovernmental Agreement.


