



IMPORTANT NOTICE

Dear local resident,

You have recently received a notification concerning road work being done for the Ashland Reservoir Tank Project. This work was delayed due to operational issues that have recently been resolved which allows us to move forward. We at Western Summit Constructors, Inc. are hoping to have as little impact on the surrounding neighbors as possible. From Monday the 22nd of April through Thursday the 16th of May, we will be beginning abandonment of Denver Waters Conduit #23 which is located on W 29th Avenue from Fenton Street to Sheridan Boulevard. Once Conduit #23 is abandoned it will be turned over to the city of Wheatridge to be used as their future storm sewer.

Concrete Works of Colorado, will begin capping the East end of Conduit #23 on the corner of Sheridan Boulevard and 29th avenue, and then will cap the West end of Conduit #23 on the corner of 29th Avenue and Fenton Street. These activities will have the following impact on the previously stated road ways.

Phase I

- The left turn lane heading East from 29th Avenue onto Sheridan Boulevard will be eliminated. Left hand turns will be allowed from through lane heading East through Sheridan Boulevard.
- The West bound lane on 29th Avenue from Sheridan Boulevard will be narrowed.

Phase II

- There will be no parking allowed on the West side of Fenton St on the corner of 29th avenue.
- The sidewalk on the Northeast Corner of Fenton St. and 29th Avenue will be detoured around the construction zone.
- There will be no left hand turns allowed from DHS Gas and Food exit on Fenton Street.
