**Contract Amendment with American Datapath, Inc. for  
Cabling Services**  
(Contract 13251A)

Information

In March of 2011, through a comparative bid, American Datapath was selected to provide cable installation services in support of Denver Water's information technology infrastructure under a two year contract. These cabling services include:

- Cat5E/Cat6 Cable installation, termination, and testing.
- Outside plant copper and fiber optic cable installation, termination, and testing.
- Indoor and outdoor conduit installation.

Services to install a dedicated fiber optic circuit at the Westside Campus to support a new redundant network core-switch (part of the IT Disaster Recovery project) were not included in the original scope of this contract with American Datapath and are estimated to cost \$75,000. Additional contract funding is required to include these services and to retain sufficient contract funding for other cabling work through the term of the contract.


Funding for this contract amendment is included in the IT Disaster Recovery project budget (MPC 3HN0056).

It is recommended the Board approve this \$75,000 contract amendment with American Datapath, Inc. for a total contract amount of \$175,000.
